By the way, in those early years there was great criticism by the established medical community about this new idea of performing major surgery through small incisions, I knew that I had to persist in improving understanding to overcome this criticism and worked to train surgeons about this new revolutionary way of helping patients. I saw the need for education on a broader scale and **founded SLS to establish standards and education for this**then new field. SLS has grown over the past 30 years to the largest non-profit multispecialty medical society of its kind in the world and of course minimally invasive and laparoscopic surgeries are now the gold standard for many fields.
